

## REMOVAL OF AND DAMAGE TO TREES IN DAINFERN'S NATURE SENSITIVE AREAS

A regrettable incident occurred last week near 9th tee box, a Nature Sensitive Area on Dainfern, whereby a resident, without authority from the DHA, illegally removed several large trees and damaged many others in the area.

Management, duly backed by our Board of Directors, took immediate steps and a letter of demand has already been sent to the offending resident. We are currently investigating all of the circumstances, but legal steps both in terms of the Environmental Laws and in terms of the Civil Laws have been initiated.

We take very seriously the destruction of our environmental areas. As a measure to ensure that all stakeholders are properly informed, we have involved the Dainfern Nature Association and other stakeholders.

The DHA strongly condemns the unauthorized destruction and or removal of any trees, anywhere on the estate and it will take the necessary steps against any person who engages in this type of activity.

## SECURITY UPGRADE: ACCESS CONTROL AND CCTV

The upgrade of the Access control and CCTV solution is nearing its completion towards the second part of Aug 2012. What has been a challenging couple of months is now starting to pay dividends as we are able to run the two CCTV systems in parallel. The upgrade to an IP based CCTV solution with HD functionality is a huge improvement on our current CCTV solutions at the gates.

The Access control upgrade from the card solution to fingerprint biometric is also in its testing phase. The new biometric readers are now being populated with the enrolled fingerprint templates and will soon be opened to residents to test and use on a daily basis. Thanks for the patience of all the residents during the upgrade of these systems. We believe that you will soon see and feel the benefit of the upgrades.

#### RED CROSS SCAM

Security in one of the surrounding Estates has been informed of people claiming to represent the Red Cross Society and requesting a donation of R150.00. The resident requested if she could transfer the donation into a bank account upon which they replied no and that they prefer to collect the cash personally. The resident then phoned the Red Cross Society who informed her that it is a scam.

Security has informed all security officers to be on alert for these people and will not allow them entry onto the Estate. It is possible that this may be a way for criminals to get access to the estates. Please be aware of this scam and keep family members and staff apprised of these scams as well.

#### CITY OF JOHANNESBURG BILLING

Following the recent visits to Dainfern by the contractors attending to non-functional electricity meters in Dainfern, who were also requested to quote on the installation of pre-paid meters, we note that we were advised that not all non -functional meters could be replaced as City Power is limiting the issue of electricity meters due to stock shortages. Similarly we could not be quoted on the installed price of pre-paid meters as the availability of stock is an issue.

We are in constant contact with City of Johannesburg, City Power and the contractors, and will provide updates as often as possible.

In addition we have recently received several enquiries from residents who received exceptionally high water bills, all based on actual meter readings. Please review your recent City of Johannesburg statements. You can check your daily average consumption which is shown on the bill and see if this is different to previous months, after taking into account any unusual activities you may be aware of. You may then lodge a complaint with COJ with regard to the unexplained differences.

# EXCERPT FROM THE STAR – 22 AUGUST 2012 RESIDENTS ALL CHARGED UP ABOUT PREPAID KILLER WATTS

Below please see an excerpt from The Star dated 22 August 2012 for your information:

Joburg prepaid electricity consumers are urged to watch their consumption carefully as they could end up being charged an additional R844.25if they exceed their limit by just one kilowatt.

About 40 000 customers have been converted by the council to prepaid, but customers have described City Power's inclining block system for prepaid tariffs as confusing and misleading.

*City Power did not inform customers that their consumption was reviewed every six months. Customers unaware that they have been moved on to a higher price scale are complaining bitterly of suddenly getting fewer units for their money since the beginning of last month.* 

City Power admitted the failure, saying customers were started on the lowest rate of consumption, but every July and

December they were rerated according to how much they used and were escalated into a higher category if they exceeded a certain amount.

However; the way the system works is that there is not only an escalating block, but escalating steps within the blocks. The result is that if a customer exceeds the limit by just one kilowatt in the last of the six-month period, they will be pushed into a higher block and charged that rate for the entire six-month period.

A prepaid customer has worked out the following: if a consumer uses 500kWh a month from July this year to December; they will pay R2475 at a rate of 82.5c per kilowatt over the six months. But if they used just one extra kilowatt, the payment jumps to R3214.50. This, he said, was because the extra kilowatt placed the customer on the next block tariff and meant they would move from paying 82.5c per kilowatt to 107.15c per kilowatt. This is R739.50 more, plus the R1.07 for the original extra kWh in December; and plus VAT of 14 percent, giving a whopping R844.25 for 1kWh.
