### SECURITY INCIDENTS BROADACRES DRIVE

We inform Residents that they should be vigilant when driving on Broadacres Drive as there were recently two incidents that were reported by Fidelity Security Services:

1. Last week an attempted hi-jacking occurred along William Nicol Drive in the early hours of the morning. A driver of a grey Nissan Sentra was approached while stopping at the intersection of Broadacres Drive and William Nicol. The driver stated that he saw the man approaching and decided to drive off. A shot was fired at the car but no one was hurt. BDA guards responded but the suspect had fled.
2. On 29 May 2011 a woman returning home to the Fields South was followed by a car with two male occupants. The driver sped up behind the woman who was entering the Fields South. When the guard noticed the car, he approached the vehicle and spotted the second occupant in the back of the car. The guard then spotted the driver handing the passenger what he suspects was a fire arm. He immediately pressed the panic button and the vehicle left. BDA cleared the area.

These incidents show us that the suspects are well funded as they used a new Lexus IS250, this also makes them difficult to detect as they do not immediately stand out.

In response to this the Fidelity Security BDA car is doing patrols along William Nicol to search for suspects hiding along the road.
