SECURITY REGISTRATION PROCESS

As part of the Security Upgrade we inform Residents that we shall be commencing the re-registration of all residents and those holding access cards from Monday 11 July 2011. It is anticipated that this process will take five to six weeks.

The intention is to replace the current access card system with a bio metric access control system, although access cards may be issued in certain circumstances. Further details will be communicated to Residents.
