#### SEWER LINE UPGRADE

Johannesburg Water has instructed D.F. Dickenson Services to attend to the installation of a new sewer line from Woodlands Park down to the Pump Station on the Golf Course. The current sewer capacity of the line is not sufficient to adequately remove all sewerage from the surrounding Estates as well as that of Dainfern itself. The installation of the new Sewer line will be in addition to the current sewer line. Installation of the new sewer line has already commenced.
