FOOTBALL UPDATE

It seems like the weather has had an adverse effect on our performances on the field. After a great couple of weeks we have just experienced one of the worst weekends of the season, although a few teams didn't have games. The only notable results came from Belgium and Canada (Under 8) and an outstanding result from our under 11 team against Randburg. Two of our under 9 teams had a bye and there were no games for the under 13 and 16 teams.

In spite of Randburg being one of the strongest teams, we managed a 1: 1 draw. The quality of our play has noticeably improved, and the use of space and possession that we practice endlessly was on display for all to see. Our goal came from a wonder strike by Thapelo Phalane, who scored from 30 yards, after a well executed corner. That goal will take some beating as the best-goal-of-the-season. What was notable about the

goal, besides from its pure quality, were the facts that, firstly, Thapelo is a defender, and secondly, he had gone forward for the corner, which is exactly what we have been going over in practice, and thirdly, having done everything right to create the opportunity, he absolutely buried it, and then wondered back to his position as if nothing had happened (before being mobbed by his team-mates. Great stuff Thapelo!!

Another outstanding performer was Sikuyo Makhaye, our under 10B goalkeeper. The team lost 3-nil, but had it not been for his outstanding display they would have lost by 6 or 7 goals. His handling, his kicking and his positional play was superb. (A comment made by the opposition coach was that if he had a few more inches in height he could become a professional goalkeeper).

Please remember that Gary does specialised goalkeeping coaching for half an hour every week day. He does one-on-one coaching as well as group coaching. As many matches as possible are attended so that he can assess the strengths and weaknesses of the keepers which enables him to focus on the problem areas during his training sessions.
